Implementation of New I-9 Form Delayed

The United States Citizenship and Immigration Services ("USCIS") has announced that use of the new I-9 form, which was to have been required beginning February 2, 2009, will not be mandated until April 3, 2009. On January 30, 2009, USCIS announced that it is delaying implementation of the rule requiring the use of the new form in order to extend the public comment period.

In the meantime, employers may continue to use the earlier version of the I-9 form until April 3, 2009, or they may use the new form.
